



**PROFESSIONAL BIOGRAPHY
STEPHANIE GLANCE
EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE KAY YOW CANCER FUND**

Stephanie Glance was named Executive Director of the Kay Yow Cancer Fund® on September 21, 2015, after almost thirty years of coaching women’s basketball. Glance was a colleague and friend to Hall of Fame Coach Kay Yow, and was by her side during the formative years of the Kay Yow Cancer Fund, until Yow’s death in 2009.

The Kay Yow Cancer Fund was officially founded on Dec. 3, 2007, from the vision of the organization’s namesake Kay Yow, former NC State University head women’s basketball coach. Coach Yow was first diagnosed with breast cancer in 1987 before succumbing to the disease on Jan. 24, 2009.

Glance was instrumental in establishing the non-profit organization in 2007, and Yow personally appointed her to serve on the Kay Yow Cancer Fund Board of Directors for life. Prior to being elected executive director, she led the Fund in the capacity of board president.

Glance served as associate head women’s basketball coach and recruiting coordinator at NC State University for 15 years where she developed a great respect and admiration for her mentor, Kay Yow. She was the interim head coach during parts of the 2004-05, 2006-07 and 2008-09 seasons, while Yow battled breast cancer. During her tenure in Raleigh, the Wolfpack made 11 NCAA appearances, four trips to the Sweet 16 and one trip to the Final Four.

After leaving NC State University in 2009, she served one year as the recruiting coordinator and special assistant to Pat Summitt, head coach at the University of Tennessee. Glance went on to become the head women's basketball coach at Illinois State University where she was named the Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year in 2011, after leading the Illinois State Redbirds to a 24-win season. The following season, after being predicted to finish sixth in the conference, Glance led the Redbirds to a second-place finish and was selected as the Women's Basketball Coach of the Year for the Missouri Valley Conference.

In 2013, Glance was recruited to take over the helm as head women's basketball coach at Columbia University, a prestigious Ivy League institution in the city of New York.

Glance played the sport she knows and loves at Rollins College in Winter Park, Fla., from 1982-1985 and earned her Bachelor of Arts in English and Education in 1985. She is a native North Carolinian and is excited to return to the Raleigh area.
